1st EVENT

R. G. C. PRIZE

Prize to become property of member winning the greatest number of times during February and March.

An additional prize will be offered on the same conditions for April and May.

Conditions: 10 birds, handicap rise and bird allowances.

1st prize, 30 bird tickets; 2d prize, 20 bird tickets.

In case of ties, prize to be shot off under same conditions.

Until further notice, the conditions governing this event, on Saturdays, will be as follows:

Two shooters to qualify.

Less than 4 shooters—1st prize, 15 bird tickets. Four shooters—1st prize, 20 bird tickets; 2d prize, 10 bird tickets. Five shooters or more—1st prize, 30 bird tickets; 2d prize, 20 bird tickets.

2d EVENT

Ten birds, handicap and bird allowances. \$2.00 entrance. Five entries to constitute a shoot.

First prize, either \$10 prize order or 40 bird tickets; 2d prize, either \$5 prize order or 20 bird tickets.

On arrival of 12 o'clock (noon) train.

\$10 entrance. Thirty birds. Handicap and bird allowances as in 10 birds; 10 birds on each ground. Scratch men to be allowed 1 bird in 30. No shooter to carry over in ties a handicap greater than his allowance in 10 birds. Positions to be drawn by lot. Prize and 40% to 1st, 30% to 2d, 20% to 3d, 10% to Club.

Twelve men necessary to constitute a shoot,

In all Club matches when there are 10 or more men shooting, the match must be shot on more than one ground.

Limit of Handicap on the Riverton Grounds shall be 30 yards.

Unless otherwise specified Boundary to be 50 yards.

* *

Unless otherwise specified the allowance of birds is for each 10 birds.

* *

In all Club events Bird Handicaps good until used. No shooter to carry over in ties a handicap greater than his allowance in 10 birds.

* *

Five shooters necessary to constitute a shoot except otherwise stated.

* *

In all events where there is an entrance fee charged, guests may participate in same, excepting special shoots. Guests not handicapped shoot at 28 yards.

* *

A shooter withdrawing cannot shoot up.
