

PRESERVATION AWARD CATEGORIES

THE RECOGNITION OF PROPERTY OWNERS WITH A PRESERVATION AWARD MAY BE BASED ON ONE OR MORE CATEGORIES AS DETERMINED BY THE SOCIETY'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS

I. PRESERVATION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESTORATION, OR REHABILITATION OF A HISTORIC RIVERTON BUILDING, STRUCTURE, OR SITE

Recognition for extraordinary achievement by an owner in the historic preservation of a local historic building, structure or site while retaining the most significant, or "character-defining," historic elements of the property.

II. ENDANGERED PROPERTY

Recognition of an owner for efforts to rescue and improve a long-neglected property.

III. IMPROVEMENTS TO A BUILDING, STRUCTURE, OR SITE LOCATED WITHIN THE RIVERTON HISTORIC DISTRICT AS LISTED ON THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES

Recognition of an owner for substantial exterior improvements to a building, structure, or site.

IV. IMPROVEMENTS TO A BUILDING, STRUCTURE, OR SITE OUTSIDE THE RIVERTON HISTORIC DISTRICT

Recognition of an owner for substantial exterior improvements to a building, structure, or site.
