A band of intrepid bicyclists will again commemorate the 1895 Tri-State Relay Race on Saturday, June 11, by riding 101.8 miles from Millburn, NJ to Riverton.

Rob Gusky, originator of the hundred-mile ride he dubbed the

Historic Riverton

Century, last made the rigorous journey in 2014.



His fundraising efforts then resulted in a marvelous souvenir of the feat-a handsome historical sign behind the Light Rail Station marking the former location of the race track near Thomas Avenue.
