The meeting will be opened promptly at 10 a.m. in the Y.W.C.A. building, 565 Stevens street, Camden, N. J. Mrs. Marion F. McDowell, Extension Specialist in Child Development and Family Relations, New Jersey College of Agriculture, and Mrs. Levi B. Stiles, State Chairman of Committee on Parent Education, New Jersey Congress of Parents and Teachers are Co-Chairmen. Mrs. Leonard G. Twitchell, President of the New Jersey Congress of Parents and Teachers, will be our first speaker. Mrs. Twitchell's topic will be "Helping Our Youngest Mothers." Mrs. Fredrick H. Allen, M. D., Director, Child Guidance Clinic, Philadelphia, Pa., will speak on "Beginnings in Behavior," after which he will answer any questions on this subject.

A very interesting skit, "Growing Up Emotionally," will be given, followed by a discussion. After Luncheon Mrs. Roda W. Bacmeister, author, Supervisor, Child Care Centers, Phila., Pa., will speak on "The School Child Builds from Experience." MODERNIZING YOUR STATE CONSTITUTION

"I can't afford to be a candidate for the Legislature," more than one responsible citizen has remarked when approached by his friends to run for the State Senate or General Assembly. Even civic-minded men and women, anxious to have a part in their State government, have to think of their pocketbook. When citizens of New Jersey approve the revised Constitution at the General Election next November 7, service in the Legislature won't necessarily represent a financial sacrifice. Senators and Assemblymen, paid \$500 a year under the ancient 1844 Constitution, will be paid \$2,000 a year under the revised charter.
