Bennett Landsman

Computers have always connected people across distances, but never before have we relied on them like we do now. They allow us to work, stay in contact with friends, and reach out to those who need a little company in these unprecedented times. But some people didn't need a virus to see that potential, and Bennett Landsman is one of those people. He got into computers in the beginning and has been pushing his career - and volunteer groups - forward ever since.



Bennett Landsman was born in Poughkeepsie, NY in 1937, where he lived until first grade when World War II began. Due to his father's job working in defense, the family moved several times. First, they went to Manhattan when he was a first grader, then back to Poughkeepsie from middle school through sophomore year, and lastly to Scranton, PA, where Bennett graduated from Scranton Central High School. From there, he attended Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, graduating in 1959 with a degree in electrical engineering with an option in large-scale computers.

At the time of his graduation, computers were on the rise but still very new. Bennett was uniquely positioned to get into the field because of his degree. Electrical engineers had the skills to build the computers, and he had been exposed to some software programming in college. As such, his first job out of school was for PhilCo. in Germantown, where he designed Logic networks, an emerging computer language, for their mainframe. As his career developed, Bennett moved all over the Philadelphia and Southern New Jersey area, living in Collingswood, NJ working for RCA as a computer designer and programmer, then a Cherry Hill consulting firm doing non-defense work in Washington, DC. It was in Cherry Hill that he met his current wife, Catherine McCall, at a Unitarian Church social, and together they moved to Palmyra, NJ.

Eventually, Bennett settled into working for the State of New Jersey, which would make up the bulk of his career. He started with the Department of Higher Education managing the data centers for eight state colleges. From there, he worked for the Department of Human Services in a variety of roles. Most of his responsibilities dealt with computer systems, acting as the liaison between the department head and the data centers.

For Bennett, computers have always been more than a career; they've been a lifelong hobby that he deeply enjoys. When IBM's microcomputer came out in 1981, Bennett was an early

adopter. The store that sold it to him suggested he reach out to the only other person who bought one from them. That man suggested that he join the Philadelphia Area Computer Society, which he did, and founded the IBM subgroup. For eight years, Bennett served as the Vice President of PACS and acted as the host and speaker at their events. He even got to introduce Bill Gates at an event for over 2,000 attendees at La Salle!

Bennett and Catherine moved to Riverton over twenty years ago, shortly after his retirement from his last role with the state, the Office of Telecommunications and Information Systems. They were hoping to find a place his mother could move into with them, so when the realtor called and said he'd found the perfect house, they jumped on it! He loved the river and the friendliness of the residents, so moving to Riverton was not a hard sell.

Bennett has had an active life and career, so he didn't just settle into an easy retirement. Once in Riverton, he immediately started getting involved. First, Michael Robinson from the Riverton Library talked him into joining a book club, and shortly after, enlisted Bennett's skills to help build the Library's first website. Always a fan of photography, retirement gave him more time to pursue that interest, and he did with gusto, joining the Maple Shade Camera Club and volunteering to take photos for the Pompeston Creek Watershed Association, Palmyra Nature Cove, Riverview Estates, and more.

It was likely Michael Robinson, too, who told Bennett about the Riverton 4th of July Committee. He became the official committee photographer, a position that didn't exist previously but has become an important staple. His photos documented the events of our little town for years, and it was Bennett who first suggested we needed a website. In the beginning, that website cataloged the photos he took and had a list of events. With his urging, we developed it into a more informative, helpful site that those new to the 4th of July festivities could use to learn about our wonderful little town.

Bennett Landsman is a man who has found fulfillment in his career and his retirement, finding ways to connect his interests to his work. Whether it was taking photos of our beautiful town, using Zoom to talk to his family, or encouraging a slightly-behind-the-curve local committee that they needed a website, Bennett has always found the fun. When asked what his words of wisdom for the town are, he said "Enjoy what you do; it's more fun that way. If you have to work, you might as well enjoy it!"
