Summary:

The Historical Society of Riverton (HSR) is awarding a cash prize of \$500 for a 1500 word essay that answers a question about Riverton's history. The winning entry will be featured on the HSR's website: www.rivertonhistory.com. Noteworthy essays that do not win the primary prize may also be published on the HSR's website. Essays will follow MLA guidelines for published works (see attachment).

The Question: What did Rivertonians do for fun 100 years ago?

In your essay, discuss the ways people entertained themselves in the 1920s. How and with whom did they socialize? Where did they go to have fun when they weren't working? What social, political, economic and technological changes were happening nationally and in this region that affected what people did for fun in the 1920s?

Where to start?
